

Travel for medical treatment or examination

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An employee may be required to travel to attend medical treatment (section 16), or a medical examination arranged by Comcare under section 57 of the SRC Act. Comcare may reimburse reasonably incurred costs associated with making the necessary journey or remaining at a place because of the journey.
